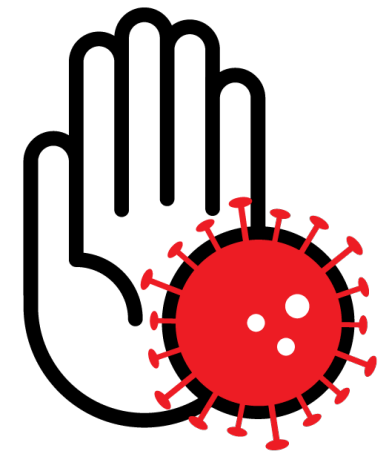


# Your Covid responsibilities on campus (and elsewhere)

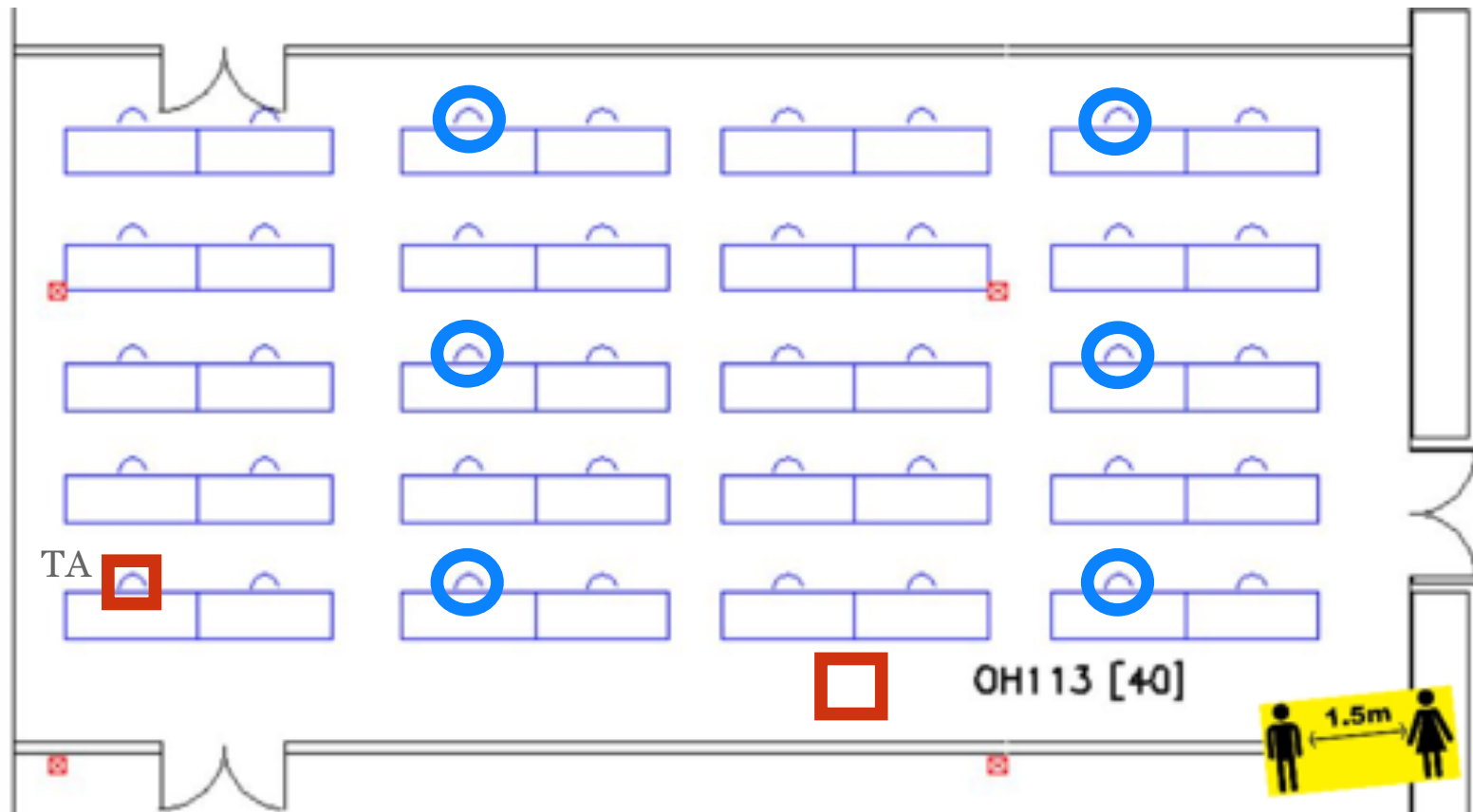
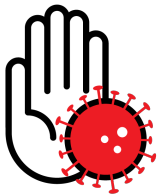

# CS-specific Covid measures (Sep 4, 2020)

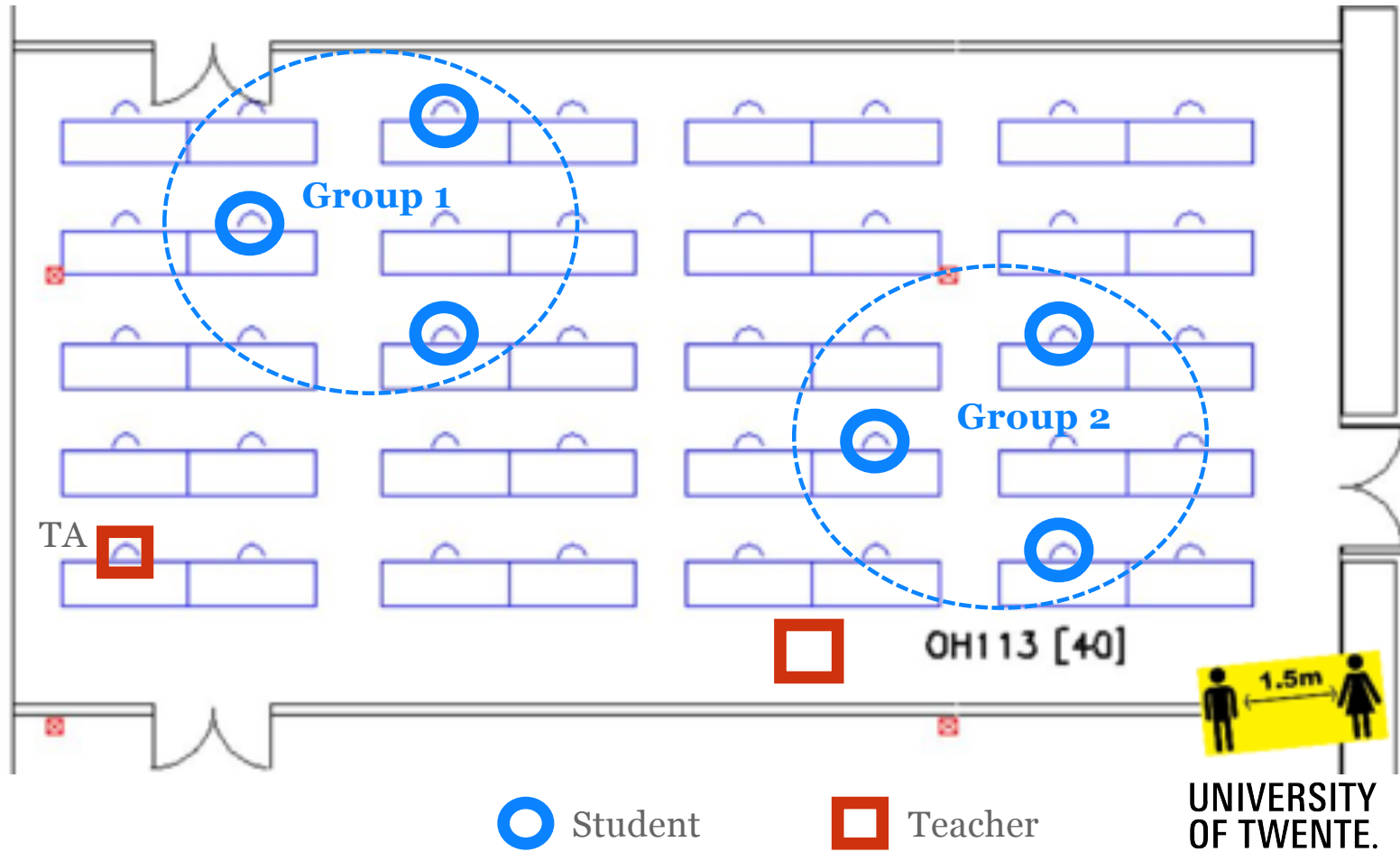
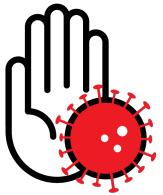
- CS-specific measures for **teaching activities**
  - All teachers and teaching assistants wear face shields at all times when they find themselves within 1,5m distance of any other person;
  - Teachers, teaching assistants and invigilators and students are encouraged, but not required, to wear a face mask (corner store quality);
  - Fresh disposable face masks (corner store quality) may be made available to all present, at the discretion of the teacher.
- CS-specific measures at all **tests**
  - All teachers and invigilators wear face shields at all times when they find themselves within 1,5m distance of any other person;
  - Teachers, invigilators and students are encouraged, but not required, to wear a face mask (corner store quality);

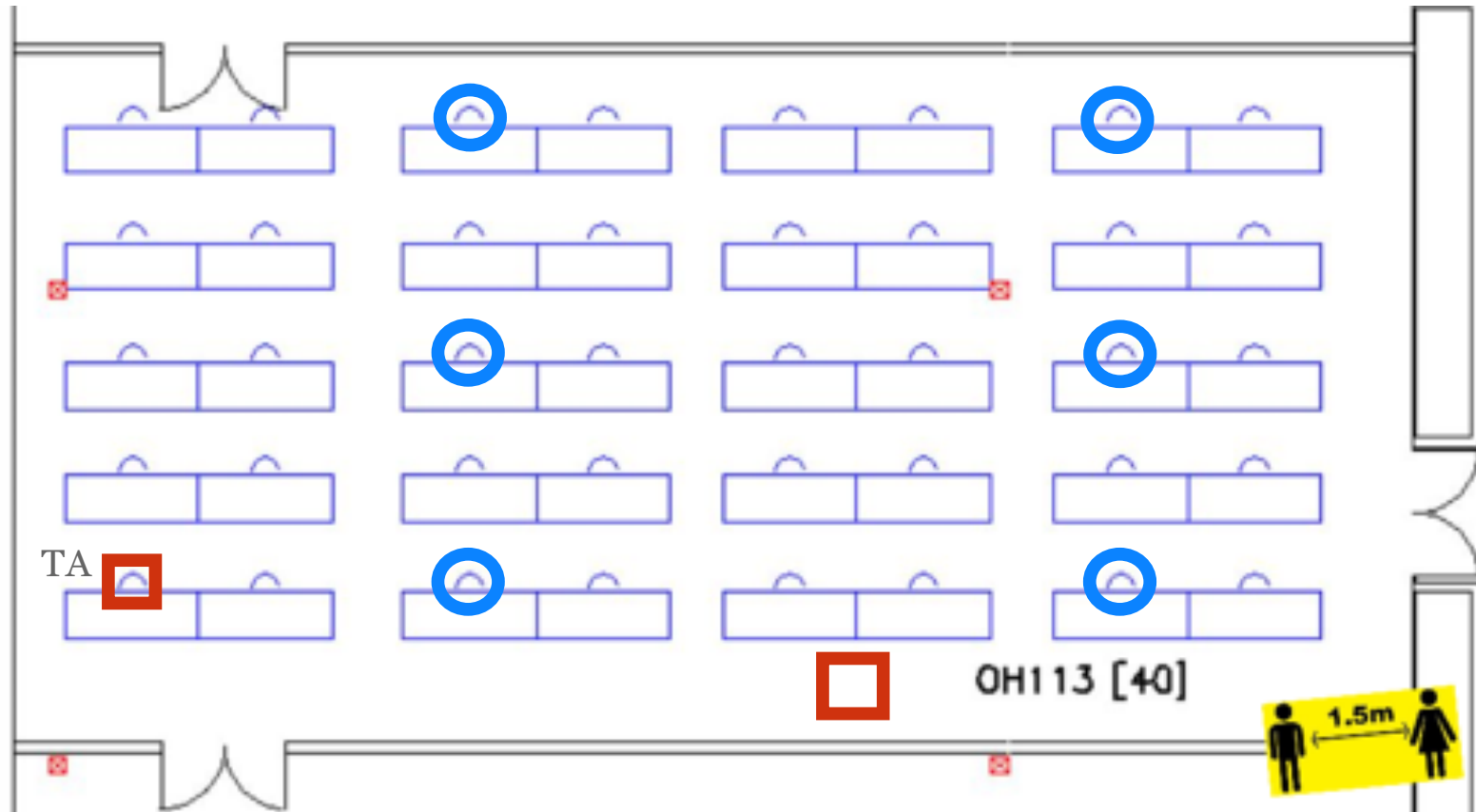

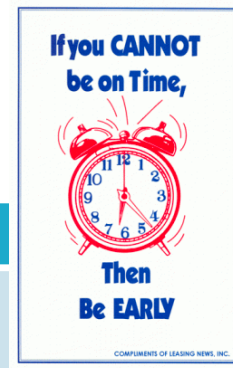

Time	What
